Buckingham Palace

Buckingham Palace is the London home of the Queen and her husband the Duke of Edinburgh. The Duke of Buckingham built the house in 1702.

The gardens of Buckingham Palace are enormous. They are the biggest private gardens in London. The Queen has garden parties there every summer. Over 8,000 people come to these parties.

The palace is very big. It is 108 metres wide, 120 metres long and 24 metres high. It has 775 rooms. The biggest room is the ballroom. It's 37 metres long. The dining room is smaller but 150 can eat there. There are 52 big bedrooms for the royal family and their guests and 188 smaller bedrooms. (But there are 'only' 78 bathrooms!) 450 people work in Buckingham Palace.

In 1993 the Queen opened some rooms of Buckingham Palace to tourists. Many just look round and say, 'Wow! The Queen lives here.'
