You can't use the internet on your phone if you ..... a data connection or wifi.
- 9 If he gets good grades, Kevin's parents will buy him a new mobile phone.  
Kevin's parents won't buy him a new mobile phone if he ..... good grades.
- 10 You aren't allowed to use a mobile phone on a plane.  
If you are on a plane, you ..... a mobile phone.
- 11 Mobile phones are safe, so people use them every day.  
People ..... use mobile phones if they weren't safe.
- 12 It's not a good idea to spend hours on your mobile phone every day.  
If I ..... you, I wouldn't spend hours on your mobile phone every day.
- 13 It's possible for a young child to break a phone if they play with it.  
A young child ..... break a phone if they play with it.
- 14 If your phone is stolen, you should call the police.  
You should call the police ..... your phone.
